Andreas Fulda is a choral conductor, music teacher and lecturer in ensemble conducting and lives in Nuremberg. He is employed by the Windsbacher Knabenchor as musical assistant and deputy choir director and continues to work freelance. As Ludwig Böhme's assistant, he is responsible for conducting register and full choir rehearsals and performances. In March 2024, he took over the artistic direction of the choir's tour of France. His duties also include repetition and organizational work, such as managing the vocal and instrumental departments.

Andreas Fulda received his master's degree in conducting from Prof. Georg Grün and Prof. Toshiyuki Kamioka at the HfM Saarbrücken after studying with Prof. Harald Jers and Prof. Stefan Blunier at the Mannheim University of Music. There he completed his bachelor's degree in choral conducting and at the same time his state examination in music teaching in the subjects of piano, singing and English. In master classes, he conducted the Kammerchor Stuttgart, the Kammerchor Consono Köln and the Kammerchor Saarbrücken, among others, and received valuable input from Frieder Bernius, Wolfgang Schäfer, Morten Schuldt-Jensen, Bernie Sherlock and Colin Metters, among others.

Before his time in Windsbach, he conducted chamber choirs, youth choirs and oratorio projects with orchestras in the southwest region of Germany. In 2021, he received a teaching position for ensemble conducting at the Karlsruhe University of Education. In addition to his work as a conductor, Andreas Fulda is active as a singer with internationally renowned ensembles such as the male choir Ensemble Vocapella Limburg and Chorus Musicus Köln. He is also active as a pianist with his sister and singer Katharina Fulda in the duo UNSINN for music of the 1920s and 1930s, which played several performances at the Meiningen State Theater in 2023.
